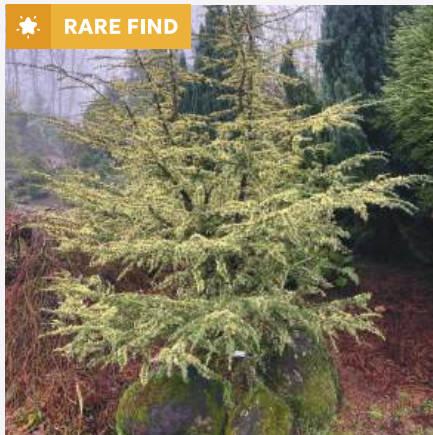

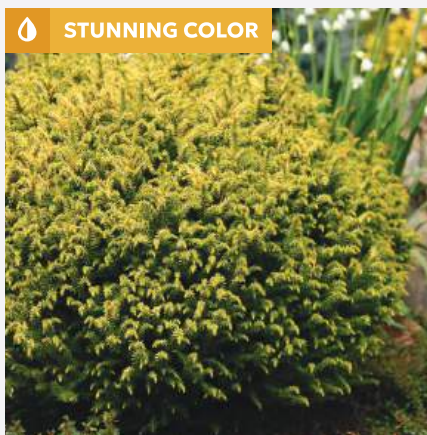

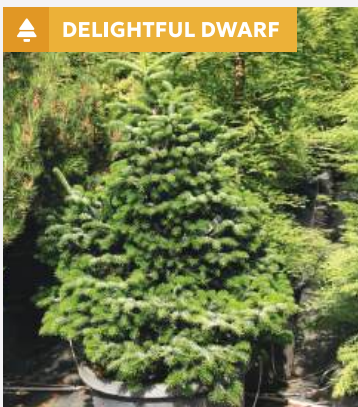

A groundcovering variety that also boasts brilliant purple cones standing upright against dark green needles. Hardy in USDA Zones 5-8

Burgundy Jewel Vine Maple

Acer circinatum

A real stunner with large, burgundy leaves. It can provide height, shade, and structure in the garden without taking over. It tolerates full sun to part shade and is the most colorful in full sun. Hardy to USDA Zone 5.



Orange Dream Japanese Maple

Acer palmatum

Stunning orange-yellow foliage outlined with red in spring, yellow-green foliage in summer outlined with orange, and glowing yellow in autumn. Orange Dream is hardy in USDA Zones 5-9 and does best in dappled sun or afternoon shade in the warmer zones from that range, but can tolerate full sun in colder regions. Excellent for containers or any style of garden. It can reach a size of 8' tall by 6' wide in 10 years.



Golden Full Moon Maple

Acer shirasawanum 'Aureum'

This is a prized variety and a must for every garden. The foliage glows golden from spring through summer before igniting into a rich assortment of reds and oranges in autumn. It has a compact, upright form and can reach 8' tall by 6' wide in 10 years. It is hardy in USDA Zones 5-9 and performs best when sheltered from very hot afternoon sun in summer and cold, burning winds in winter and early spring.



Woodland Gardens

Peace, shelter, serenity, birdsong... woodland gardens bring all this and more to your property. Trees providing shade are a must, so why not grow varieties that are extraordinary? Brightly-colored smaller varieties are perfect understory choices along with some glowing perennials and grasses.

This tiny miniature selection forms a tight, perfectly round ball. It has bright green foliage in spring that darkens to a rich tone the rest of the year. Perfect for a rock garden or fairy garden, or just a solid anchor point for a larger setting. Hardy in USDA Zones 3-8.



Virgata Serbian Spruce

Picea omorika

With irregular, snaking branches and stunning, two-tone green and blue coloration, Virgata is a real showstopper. Hardy in USDA Zones 3-8.



The Blues Colorado Spruce

Picea pungens

The powder-blue hue of this weeping spruce is hard to match, and you can decide how you want to direct the branches. It could be tall and weeping, windswept, or even ground covering. Hardy in USDA Zones 3-8.



Four Season Gardens

Many gardeners have accepted the fact that their beds go to sleep in the winter and the ground will be bare and bleak until spring. This doesn't have to be the case! By thoughtfully selecting a palette of plants with year-round interest, your landscape can be a riot of color from January 1 to December 31.

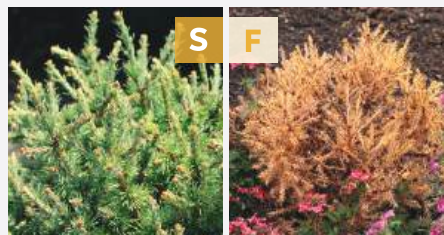

PINES – PINUS

Pines are a genus with many species and diverse characteristics. They can generally be placed into two categories: hard pines and soft pines. Hard pines have stiff needles in bundles of two or three, hard wood, and tolerance for wet soils. Soft pines have soft needles in bundles of five, soft wood, and more need for well-draining soil.

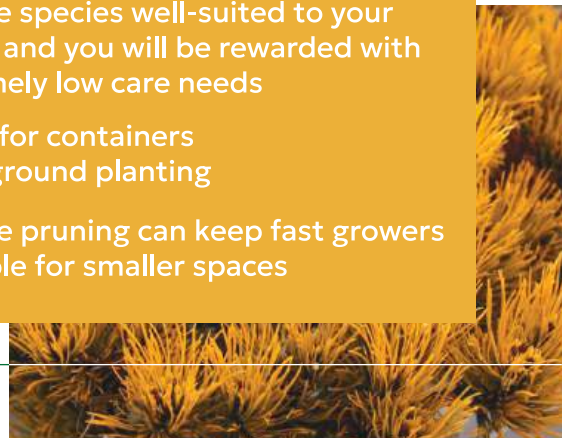

Lemon Mugo Pine

Pinus mugo

A gorgeous and unique spreading pine with glowing yellow foliage all year long. Lemon is a must-have! It is extremely cold-hardy and grows well in USDA Zones 2-8.



Smidtii Bosnian Pine

Pinus heldreichii (leucodermis)

This dense, globose selection of Bosnian pine has a rich green color and short needles that form a cup at the branch tips. A wonderful, slow-growing selection, perfect for a rock garden. Hardy in USDA Zones 5-8.



Rockley WB Austrian Pine

Pinus nigra ssp. laricio

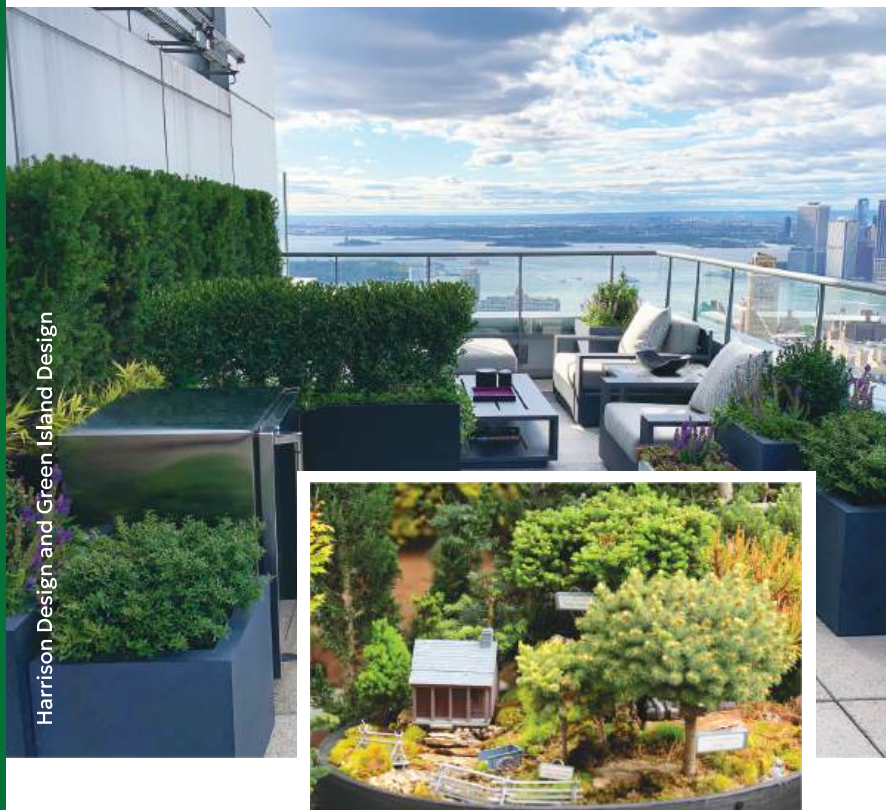
This is an eye-catching pine you probably won't find in anyone else's garden! With long, gently twisting, gray-green needles, it slowly grows into a delightfully compact yet billowing pyramid giving unbelievable form and texture to any space. It was discovered as a chance genetic mutation called a Witch's Broom on a full-sized Austrian Pine, then propagated for us all to enjoy in our gardens. Hardy in USDA Zones 4-9.

Container Gardens

Poor soil? Limited space? Love a plant but it's just a little too tender for your winter lows?

Container gardening solves all these problems and more. Many dwarf conifers are extremely well-suited to growing in containers for many years, especially if you are willing to do some shoot and root pruning from time to time. You can even grow a full ornamental garden on a patio or balcony with this method, no planting ground required. Connect to a hose with drip emitters and you can just sit back, relax, and enjoy your accessible, low-maintenance garden. We have lots of miniatures that are perfect for fairy gardens as well!

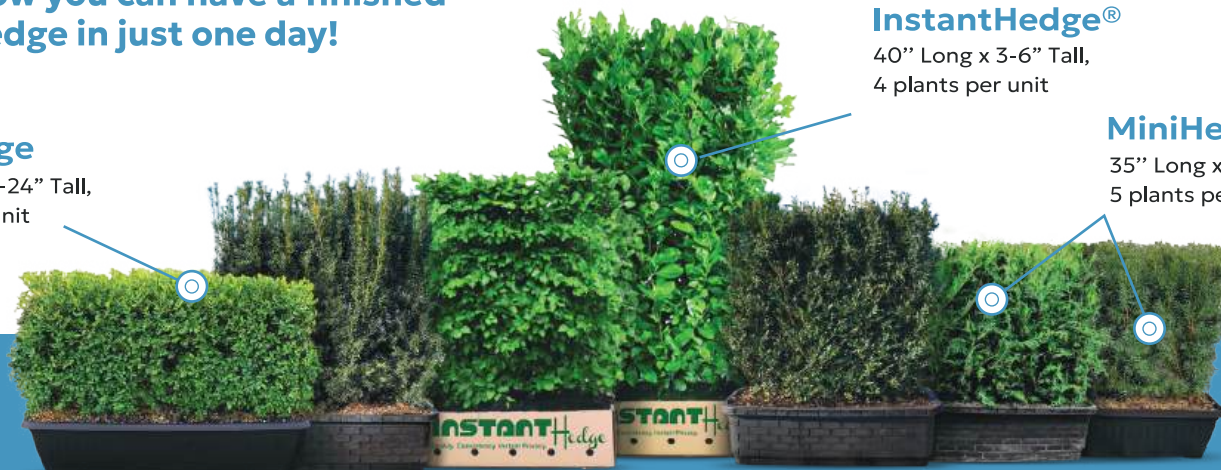
